Course Description

Suturing is a turning point towards Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery. Combination of the correct stitch and knot tying can be responsible for the success of a complex surgery. Appropriate rules make difficult things easy. The Romeo's Gladiator Rule put suturing at the hands of all laparoscopists. The knowledge acquired by Romeo's Gladiator School explain which knots are safe and unsafe or dangerous and how to perform them. This course provides a broad comprehension about the art of laparoscopic suturing, mixing theory and practice.

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of this activity, the participant will be able to:

- 1) identify safe, unsafe and dangerous knots;
- 2) perform bimanual knot tying following the Romeo's Gladiator Rule;
- 3) Loading the needle and stitching with both hands and supra pubic route;
